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The SensusAccess service automates the conversion of documents into a range of accessible formats, including Braille, mp3, Daisy, and e-book for individuals who have visual or reading impairments and are registered with their Local Disability Coordinator. SensusAccess can also be used to convert otherwise inaccessible documents such as image-only pdf files or scanned images into accessible formats.

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If you choose to use SensusAccess, you must understand and agree to abide by the following terms and conditions:

1. You must be registered as a student at an eligible Harvard institution.
2. You must have a valid Harvard.edu email address.
3. You must have a documented need for accessible format materials.
4. You must be approved through your Local Disability Coordinator.
5. You must not copy, share, or reproduce any accessible format materials.
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7. You understand that unauthorized use of accessible format materials will result in the termination of your access to SensusAccess and may also result in disciplinary action through your local administrative board.
