Definitions of Minimum Student Level of Participation

AP (Active Participation) = The student's knowledge of the patient/their condition resulted from an active role, including one or more of the following:
The student:

- took components of the history/physical exam
- engaged in clinical reasoning/helped generate a differential diagnosis
- participated in the diagnostic and management plan

OR the student performed or actively assisted in performance of a specific skill or procedure

OB (Observation) = The student is able to describe the differential diagnosis, diagnosis and management of a patient's condition, but their knowledge of the patient resulted from an exclusively passive role, i.e. the student saw the patient with other members of the team and observed other team members engaged in AP

OR the student observed another team member perform a specific skill or procedure
